Setting Prisoners Free- P.S.

Redding, CA with his wife, Jan. Dennis grew up in California and his life intersected with Influencers about 5 years ago.

He and his wife owned Tennis and Athletic clubs in the Carmel/Monterey area. This business guided them to Redding, CA where they were investing in a club.

Dennis felt a calling in his life to "walk alongside pastors" and begin doing so at his new church, The Stirring. He found out they needed help with Facilities, and Dennis, with his club experience, knew Facilities. He started working at the church and eventually became the Men's Ministry pastor.

He was also part of the National Praver Breakfast, which had a contingency in the western states. This is where he met his friend, Thad Montgomery. Thad, as you may know, is part of Influencers West and Pete McKenzie's Band of Brothers. Dennis was struck when Thad told him, "I found something I'm committing the rest of my life to."

A few weeks later, Dennis received a package with a Journey to the Inner Chamber and Prayer Cottage books in it. He put the



Last month, we told you about how God is using The Journey in prisons. Just to add to that, here's a couple of neat stories we heard this past month:

One of our guides went to

visit the prison, hoping and praying that some of the men would understand the allegory of The Journey to the Inner Chamber, especially The Bridge, which symbolized a walk into salvation and the Kingdom. It was a strange visit, one in which he didn't get much response. He was disappointed and a bit discouraged as he left. As he was leaving, he noticed a man, covered in Tattoos, with a Golden Retriever dog, standing outside, sweating in the heat. He felt the Lord's prompting to go talk to the man.

After a bit of small talk, the man said he recognized the Guide. Much to our Guide's surprise, he discovered that this man had gone through The Journey 6-Week study while in Jail several months before. The man went on to say how that book and the process changed his life and has kept him out of trouble since. The Guide left encouraged and inspired that God was moving in ways he never expected.

Mike was excited about bringing The Journey to inmates in Oklahoma. He worked the proper channels with the Chaplain and had his first date set to go into the prison. He got a surprise phone call that they had moved his date up one week. Unfortunately, he had just been offered tickets in a Suite to watch the Oklahoma City Thunder and San Antonio Spurs playoff game on the same night. He hesitated, and then said, "I'll be there."

He passed up the sweet basketball tickets and disappointed his wife, but went on his faithful journey to go visit the prisoners. When he got there, they informed him that the prison was on "lock-down" and he couldn't have his group. In disbelief, Mike sat in the room where he was supposed to do his group. He lowered his head in prayer, "Lord, please get the men in here!" As soon as he finished his prayer, the inmates started coming into the room. His Journey Group was back on! It was an amazing, edifying group, and Mike knew he was exactly where he was supposed to be! books aside for a few months and finally read The Journey book. Upon finishing it, he gave it to his friend, Leo, telling him he thought he should read it. Leo read it and immediately found the Influencers website, looking for more information. He came into the Senior Pastor's office, pounded his fist on his desk and said, "We've got to do The Journey!"

They put together a group of leaders in the church, dubbing it a Trial Journey Group and started going through the process. This was a stretch for this church because they had an unwritten rule: "WE DON'T DO PROGRAMS."

Just as they were discovering that The Journey had validity, Dennis was invited to Malibu, CA for the Influencers Leadership Retreat. It was here that Dennis got plugged into the Influencers network and met Frank Khalil, who offered to help train him in The Journey. Around the same time, one of the pastors from The Stirring attended an Influencers Bakersfield weekend retreat and was blown away. While at the retreat, the pastor also met Rocky and really caught the vision of Influencers. Soon after, Journey groups started in earnest in Redding.

Another Journey brother is joining the prison effort, motivated by the fact that his son is an inmate. He is encouraged to know there is hope for his boy.

God is moving, guys! We are so privileged to be working with Him.

Global Spotlight



Zambia and Zimbabwe

A team of Influencers from Southern California traveled to Zambia and Zimbabwe, Africa this month with a

suitcase full of Journey materials.

They are training local pastors and village leaders in Livingstone, Zambia, then moving to

Victoria Falls, Gwayi River, Kamativi, Lupote and Harare in Zimbabwe. In Hwangi (Jasper's hometown) the local prison Chaplain



has requested to be trained as a Journey Guide to allow him to teach the Journey to those incarcerated. Dennis Ruvolo, our Chino Prison Journey Guide is on the team in Africa. Jack Stillman and Glen Megill are the other Influencers team members.

<u>Rwanda</u>

Eric Neuyou, the man from Cameroon who works at Wal-Mart in NWA, continues leading a Journey Group in Rwanda through the 6-Week Study. Due to technology limitations, he is leading the group via Texting. In spite of the method of communication, Eric reports that the men are "getting it" and very excited. Another Journey brother was in Rwanda on a mission trip and made connections with the lead pastor of this It wasn't long before Dennis started seeing some of the same life transformation through The Journey that men were seeing in other parts of the country. The Stirring became a host Journey church and many groups started multiplying. This past year, The Stirring had 11 Journey Groups and another church in town, Risen King, had 4 Journey Groups.

They are about to do another 6-Week Study of The Journey and plan to launch several more Journey Groups in the Fall. Dennis is also overseeing expansion efforts in Sacramento, Washington and Oregon.

We are SO thankful for Dennis and his service, his heart for churches and pastors and the blessing he is to our staff.

Keep Dennis in your prayers as he continues to grow into his full-time role with Influencers.
